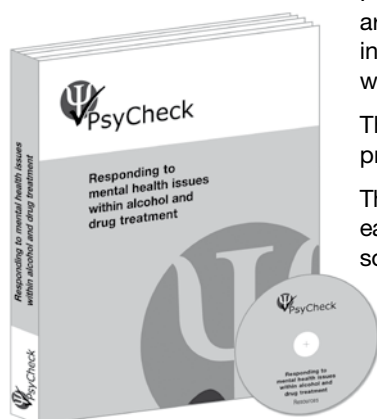

People with comorbid depression or anxiety as well as alcohol and other drug use problems are frequently managed within AOD treatment settings, without specialist mental health intervention. PsyCheck has been designed as an evidence-based treatment program to use within this context.

The screening tool has been scientifically validated, the intervention manual contains best practice techniques and there is a focus on case formulation and reflective practice.

The design of the PsyCheck program draws these elements into a single package that can be easily incorporated into routine AOD practice. It is presented as a manualised but flexible package, so that AOD clinicians with a broad range of experience and backgrounds are able to use it.

The Psycheck training manual includes the following resources: Program introduction / Screening Tool User's Guide / Clinical Treatment Guidelines / Training and Clinical Supervision Guidelines / Program Implementation Guidelines / Program References.
