A FRESH MOVE

Spectrum will commence a new chapter when we move to 110 Church Street, Richmond from January 2018.

The new location will bring all of Spectrum's treatment, research and education services together in the one building, and will be a positive step forward for our consumers, our staff and the community in general. The site will be shared with Turning Point, Victoria's leading addiction support service.

SAME OUTSTANDING CARE

The new site will ensure we continue to provide highly-accessible, outstanding care well into the future. All services currently offered by Spectrum in Ringwood and Fitzroy will be provided from the new location and there will be no change to current referral processes.

While the Richmond site will become Spectrum's central location, consumers who live in the eastern region will have the option to continue receiving some aspects of their treatment in the Ringwood region in the immediate future.

Spectrum's new site is serviced by a range of public transport options. The most direct route is via tram route 78 which runs past the building on Church Street. Alight at stop 63. This tram also passes East Richmond train station.

The site is also within walking distance of tram routes 48 and 75 along Bridge Road (alight at stop 18, then walk up Church Street) and routes 12 and 109 along Victoria Street (alight at stop 21, then walk down Church Street). For further public transport options, visit www.ptv.vic.gov.au
